**Sen reaches semis, Sindhu bows out**

Council Bluffs (USA): Indian badminton player Lakshya Sen reached the men's singles semifinals of the US Open 2023 but two-time Olympic medalist PV Sindhu lost her women's singles match and crashed out of the tournament, here. Lakshya defeated compatriot S Sankar Muthusamy Subramanian 21-10, 21-17 in his quarterfinal match on Friday night. Commonwealth Games 2022 champion Sen dominated S Sankar and raced to a 7-1 lead early on and rode the momentum to take the first game. The second game saw S Sankar put up a sterner fight but it wasn't enough to push the match to a third game and Lakshya eventually won the contest in 38 minutes.

**Aditi slips to tied-20th at Dana Open**

Sylvania (Ohio): Indian golfer Aditi Ashok had an up and down second round of 1-under, leaving her at Tied-20th position at the Dana Open. Aditi, who shot 66 on the first day, is now 6-under after two rounds. She was Tied-5th after the opening round. In a tournament where the leaderboard is rather tight, she is only five shots behind with two more rounds to go at the Highland Meadows. American Annie Park birdied seven of her last 10 holes for an 8-under 63 card and took a two-stroke lead over the recently crowned US Women's Open champion Allisen Corpuz, Linn Grant and Jaravee Boonchant. The 28-year-old Park, who won the 2018 ShopRite LPGA Classic for her lone tour title, started from the tenth. Annie birdied the 13th and 18th and added birdies on the first four holes on the front nine.

**West Ham announce sale of Declan Rice**

London: West Ham United confirmed on Saturday that their skipper Declan Rice has left the club for a British record transfer fee. "West Ham United can confirm that agreement has been reached for Declan Rice to leave the Club for a British record transfer fee," said a statement from The Hammers. As per Sky Sports, Arsenal, who has not been mentioned in the statement, is yet to announce Rice's arrival to the club for £105m, a record fee between two English clubs. The 24-year-old leaves the club after making 245 senior appearances, the last of which saw him lift the UEFA Europa Conference League and ending club's 43-year wait for a big title, as per club's official website.

**Devang, Hemant shine for SSCB**

Itanagar: The Services Sports Control Board (SSCB) continued their domination as nine of their pugilists progressed into the finals on day five at the 5th Junior Boys National Boxing Championships in Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh. Devang (54kg) gave the perfect start to team SSCB with a sensational 5-0 win over Uttar Pradesh's Sundram Yadav. Devang looked at his absolute best in the bout and controlled the game throughout to grab the win. This is Devang's third consecutive unanimous win in the competition. He will be up against Nenthok Hodong of Arunachal Pradesh in the summit clash.

**Atwal makes cut at Senior Major**

Akron (Ohio): Arjun Atwal made his second successive Major cut on the PGA Tour Champions as he shot a second straight 2-over 72 and ensured weekend action at the Kaulig Companies Championship. His rounds of 72-72 gave him a total of 4-over 144 and he is now T-27, two places better than the first round at Firestone Country Club.

**Shubhankar makes early exit**

Gullane (Scotland): Indian golfer Shubhankar Sharma made another early exit, shooting 4-over 74 and missing the cut at the Genesis Scottish Open at The Renaissance Club. The youngest Indian ever to have won on the DP World Tour back in 2017 has been struggling to score well despite his game not having any technical shortcomings. Sharma had four bogeys and no birdies on a course, which is challenging at most times.

# Panchal keeps West hopes alive

South bowlers led by V Koushik apply pressure as they defend a big target of 298 to claim the title

**Priyank Panchal's** 92 helped West Zone stay in the hunt in pursuit of a target of 298 to win the Duleep Trophy against South Zone in Bengaluru on Saturday.

The match is in the balance as West Zone reached 182/5 at stumps on day four with Panchal batting on 92 and new batsman Atit Sheth yet to open his account.

They need another 116 runs to top the target and clinch the trophy but it will be a stiff challenge going into the final day as Panchal is the only mainstay and his effort will dictate the result of the match.

Panchal and Sarfaraz Khan, who made a crucial 48, were the only two batsmen keeping the West chase alive.

The South bowlers led by **Vasuki Koushik**, who picked up 3/28, wrecked the West top order with the likes of Prithvi Shaw, Cheteshwar Pujara and



Suryakumar Yadav all back in the pavilion without making much of an impact.

All three batsmen fell victim to Koushik's bowling after struggling to get into a rhythm while batting.

Harvik Desai was out leg

before to Vijaykumar Vyshak while Sarfaraz perished after a well-made 48, that comprised five boundaries and a six.

Panchal's innings consisted of 11 boundaries as he took 205 balls to construct

his effort at a strike rate of 44.87.

It was a knock that was the need of the hour for West Zone and Panchal delivered when some of the big names on that scoresheet struggled to get going.

Among the South bowlers apart from Koushik, Vyshak and Sai Kishore claimed a wicket apiece to keep a leash on the West batsmen in their chase.

"At this level, we have quality batsmen and the margin of error is very small. If you look at one on the leg side, to which Pujara got out. I stick to my strength and I feel that with my kind of pace I hit the right length and move the ball from there, even the best batsmen could get out," said Koushik.

## SL eyeing another shot at WTC final

Sri Lanka was in contention for the World Test Championship final until March. That prospect has whetted its appetite to get there in the new cycle.

The campaign starts on Sunday, when Sri Lanka plays Pakistan in Galle in the first of two tests.

"We had a pretty good campaign in the last World Test Championship and at one point we had a chance to make it to the finals," Sri Lanka skipper Dimuth Karunaratne said. "We would have liked to finish things off better but our last series in New Zealand didn't go the way we want. But this is a new opportunity and we are looking forward for the challenge."

Left-arm quick Shaheen Afridi returns for Pakistan after a year out of the Test side due to a knee injury, and the visitors are pinning their hopes on him to get going against the Lankans.

## Sreeshankar qualifies

Star athlete wins silver medal at Asian meet, enters Olympics

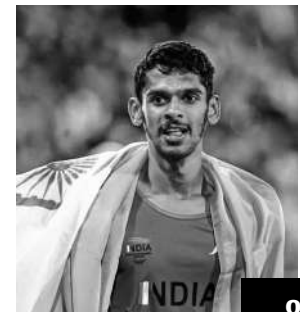

Star Indian long jumper Murali Sreeshankar on Saturday qualified for the 2024 Paris Olympics after winning a silver medal in the Asian Athletics Championships with a second career-best effort of 8.37m here.

The 24-year-old Sreeshankar achieved the Olympic qualification with his final round jump of 8.37m. The Paris Games mark is 8.27m and the qualification period began on July 1.

Yu Tang Lin of Chinese Taipei won the gold with a fourth round jump of 8.40m, which is the third best effort in the world this season.

Sreeshankar has already qualified for the Budapest World Championships in Au-



gust with his career-best and world second-ranked jump of 8.41m during the qualification round of the National Inter-State Championships last month.

Earlier, Santhosh Kumar won bronze medal in men's 400m hurdles with a personal

best time of 49.09 seconds on the fourth and penultimate day of competitions. Santhosh clocked the fastest time by an Indian in men's 400m hurdles this year when he finished behind gold medal winner Mohammed Hemeida Bassem (48.64 seconds) of Qatar and Yusaku Kodama (48.96) of Japan.

The 25-year-old's previous best was 49.49 which he had clocked last year.

Another Indian Yashas Palaksha had also qualified for the final but he did not take part.

No Indian has ever won a men's 400m hurdles gold in Asian Championships.

their first goal in the fourth minute of additional time and two minutes later Joyson Chettiar scored the equalizer. In the tie-breaker, India On Track showed better nerves and succeeded in converting three of their five attempts through Chettiar, Rohan D'Souza and Vernon Koli to clinch the win, while Om Saidham converted only one through Tanishq Gadge and finished runners-up. Earlier, Soccer Saga SA defeated Kopana FC 1-0 in the third place match. Soccer Saga striker Soham Shintre

scored the all-important winning goal.
